Our Work

What a busy start to the Summer Term we have already had! We started our topic of 'Minibeasts' by reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and tasting fruits from the story. Our caterpillars have arrived and we are excited about watching them grow and change into butterflies. We also will be learning about other minibeasts, including ladybirds, bees, worms and snails.

In Numeracy we will be extending our knowledge of numbers beyond 10 and developing our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will also be exploring shape and tessellation.

In Literacy we are developing our writing skills with daily handwriting sessions and regular word, phrase and sentence writing activities. We will be creating Minibeast Fact books recording what we have discovered. The children also have daily RWI sessions,

In Summer 2 we will be exploring the wider world, investigating jungles and under the sea. We will also hold our annual Beach Day.
